Project brief

TAO-Pilipinas rendered design consultancy work for the Columban Fathers, a missionary society of priests (Missionary Society of St. Columban), for the proposed reconstruction of their mission center in the Philippines in 2009. Architectural schematic design and development concepts were formulated for the proposed Columban Mission Center in Singalong, Manila.

A consultation meeting on the details of the proposed project was conducted with Fr. Jude Genovea, Fr. Patrick Donoghue and Fr. Dominic Nolan. A design concept and a concept board were presented as well as schematic floor plans. The final output included floor plans, elevations, sections and perspective images. The use of environment-friendly building materials and technologies were also incorporated to the development concept for the mission center. Ideas about green roof, renewable energy, rainwater harvesting, passive cooling, and use of alternative building materials were also introduced to the Columban Fathers.
