Project brief

After tropical storm Ondoy (Ketsana) brought severe flooding and devastation in Metro Manila in September 2009, TAO-Pilipinas launched an appeal to help affected families in partner communities. TAO conducted a post-disaster assessment of the communities in Quezon City, Navotas City, and in San Mateo, Rizal. TAO raised funds with the help of individual donors and supporters and received total cash donations of PHP 42,000 and USD 600 for relief operations.

TAO-Pilipinas mobilized the distribution of food items and medicine packages to various community associations in Quezon City including SAMASAPE in North Fairview, UNNAI in Commonwealth, BAKAS in Bagong Silangan, SAMAGKADA in Daang-Tubo, Diliman, and Sitio Kislap in North Faithview. In Tanza, Navotas City, MASAGANA, Samahang Kababaihan sa Bicol Area, and Chungkang Neighborhood Association received relief packs, along with a community in Sitio Ibayo in San Mateo, Rizal.

Building materials for the repair of damaged houses of partner communities in barangays Tangos and Tanza in Navotas City were also part of the post-disaster assistance. The Philippine Misereor Partnership (PMPI) also provided additional food supplies for TAO's relief operations and Starbucks CSR donated tarpaulin streamers to be used for house repairs.
